Mr. Malone earned his J.D. from Columbia University and his B.S. from Georgetown University.

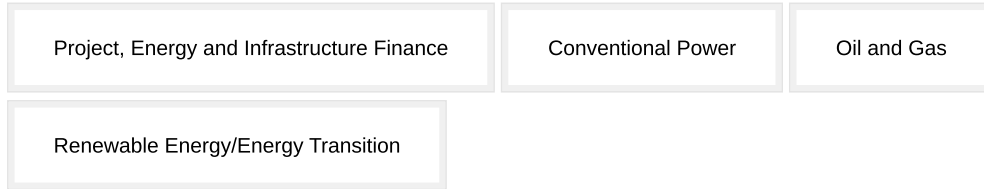
